About the Clean Air Fund





- We are a global philanthropic initiative with a mission to tackle ambient air pollution around the world
- We launched in 2019 at the UN General Assembly
- We raise and deploy philanthropic funding to:
 - Support partners working to improve air quality from grassroot organisations to international institutions
 - Strengthen the field by connecting people, mobilising resources and sharing what's working
- We work in 3 regions and have a global programme
- We will expand into Africa in 2022



Our work on air quality data



- Data is foundational for action on air quality
- We are making grants that improve the accessibility, usability and actionability of air quality data across four workstreams:



1. PILOTING AND INNOVATION

GOAL: Cost and capacity are no longer barriers to widespread monitoring



2. DATA FOR ENGAGEMENT

GOAL: Citizens understand the quality of the air that they breathe



3. DATA INTO POLICY

GOAL: Policymakers have good enough data on which they make informed decisions



4. SHARING AND SCALING BEST PRACTICE

GOAL: Data, knowledge, and experience is widely shared across a connected field

• Our goal is that air quality data is ubiquitous: that citizens understand the quality of the air that they breathe and that every policymaker has good enough data on which they make informed decisions
